

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

We understand that public transportation can be difficult. It can be both unreliable and expensive. Below is a list of a variety of non-emergency transportation resources or services in the DFW area, ranging in affordability, location, and type.

OVERALL RESOURCE

- Call 211 or go to <https://www.211texas.org/> and scroll down to aging/disability. Then select “transportation resources” and select the option that relates most to your needs.

SELF-PAY:

- [Star Transit](#) is an affordable, out-of-pocket transportation service for those South-East of Dallas. They have connections to DART stations that, while requiring a transfer, provide affordable transportation further into the DFW area.
- [DART](#) has bus, rail, streetcar, car, and paratransit options for transportation around the DFW area at an affordable, out-of-pocket price.
- [MedConnect](#) is an out-of-pocket wheelchair transport company serving Dallas, Denton, Collin, Tarrant, and parts of Rockwall County. They are known for their competitive ride rates.
- [CareTrips](#) is an out-of-pocket service that provides accessible, door-to-door transportation in the DFW area. They also offer long distance travel throughout the state and to surrounding states.

MEDICAID/ MEDICARE:

- [Medicaid NEMT](#) is available for Medicaid beneficiaries for transportation to health care services.
- [Wellpoint](#) also offers transportation to healthcare services for Medicaid beneficiaries.
- [iMEDIC Transportation](#) is a wheelchair accessible transportation option in the DFW area that will bill Medicare, Medicaid, or private insurance when taking you to healthcare services. They also offer transportation to personal errands for an out-of-pocket price.
- [Tx NEMT](#) is another option for transportation to healthcare services that will bill Medicare or Medicaid. They also accept patients willing to self-pay for other personal errands.
